MEMBERSHIP

The Association currently has 34 members and a waiting list of 6 persons. The next person on the list has been waiting since August last year for a plot to become available.

MANAGEMENT & FINANCE

Minutes of the AGM held on 12th Jan. 2012 together with the Financial Report for year ended 31st Dec. 2011 have already been submitted to the Parish Council.

CONDITION OF PLOTS

The general condition of all plots is excellent and the surrounding areas are well maintained.

A line of hedging has now been planted to screen the newly created orchard and wild garden from the allotment plots. The hedging together with an oak tree sapling were provided free of charge by the Woodlands Trust to mark the Queens Diamond Jubilee Year. A planting ceremony was held on Thursday 5th April when the oak tree was planted on behalf of the Parish Council by Cllr. Elizabeth Child accompanied by the Chairman of the Parish Council.
